I hope our newsletters and Covid updates are giving you sufficient updates on ministry at PVS. Our on-campus attendance is between 180 to 250 per Sunday (that's between 1/4 and 1/3 of regular attendance before Covid). If you forget to make a reservation for the 10:30 service, come to church anyway. We have 250 seats available in the worship center and 150 seats in the FLC, all socially distanced.

We are requesting you bring school supplies. We make those available to our teachers every year. Those are due beginning August 2-23.

We will participate in the Operation Christmas Child shoe box ministry. A list will be provided for the items we will be collecting in September. If you want to bring a box already packed, that is great as well.

Sunday School reopening is another serious decision. We are monitoring the school system for at least a month to determine what we will do. If the virus spikes, we will continue to delay having Sunday morning Bible Study.

On the day I wrote this letter, there were 42 patients with Covid at Floyd Medical Center. I do consult with medical personnel weekly to assist with our decision making about remaining open. Our volunteers on Sundays are there to assist us in meeting requirements to provide a safe environment to worship.

I miss seeing you. I look forward to the development of a vaccine so we may put this virus in our past.


