God called us to invest the prime years of our life with you. We've never lived this long in any other place since we were married almost forty-five years ago.

We realize this part of our journey will end one day. We just want you to know we consider you a blessing to us. When I've made mistakes, you have forgiven. When we had victories, you celebrated with us. The skinny preacher with thick black hair was the best you could do.

I'm thankful for Delaine. For forty-two years of ministry, she has supported me behind the scenes. You don't see all she does. I would have walked away from ministry if it had not been for her daily prayers and encouragement. The role of a pastor's wife is difficult. People do not like her that do not care for the pastor, even though she doesn't know the conflict. She's my number one fan and number one critic. I'm blessed to have her as my wife.
