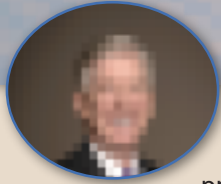

The choir will meet at 7:15 p.m. on Wednesdays after Wednesday night service.



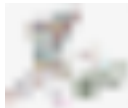
## Orchestra Rehearsal
